1. Credibility – Ocean Trust’s Nine Conservation Awards Distinguish Its Approach

Ocean Trust has received nine conservation awards from Texas State Radio, Texas Council on Environmental Quality, EPA, US Fish & Wildlife Service, Coastal America, Department of Interior, NOAA, The White House, and *Seafood Business*. 2. Substance – Programs That Make A Difference...No Talk, Just Results

Some groups talk a good game, Ocean Trust gets things done. That’s why Ocean Trust is consistently recognized by its federal and state conservation partners. Last year, we installed solar panels on the Tepehuajes sea turtle restoration camp, helped support the Southeastern Fisheries Sustainability Roundtable, sponsored construction of pedestrian bridges in the Cortez FISH Reserve, and joined Atlantic coast shellfish reef projects.



3. Solutions – Ocean Trust Filed Assessment Supporting Mexican Shrimp Recertification

In 2010, Ocean Trust conducted an independent assessment of the Mexican shrimp fishery compliance with US TED requirements corresponding with US officials and meeting with Mexican government and industry to provide additional documentation supporting the re-certification of shrimp exports.



4. Research – Advancing Sustainability with New Gear Development...Shrimp Deck Hoppers

Ocean Trust is developing and testing new deck gear with shrimpers that will further enhance product quality and shelf-life without artificial treatment to produce a natural chem-free product and reduce impacts on bycatch species.



5. Restoration – Habitat Enhancement for Important Commercial Species

We get our hands dirty propagating coastal wetland plants at our native plant nurseries on the Gulf Coast and restore estuaries that produce fish, shrimp, crab, oysters. In 2010, we started work on an inshore reef in North Carolina to enhance grouper species with our partners Bonefish Grill and Inland Seafood.



6. Science – Bringing Industry & Scientists Together on Sustainability

In 2010, Ocean Trust also organized an international workshop on *Science & Sustainability* to review status of fish stocks from global, regional and national fisheries; clarify misconceptions in the media; and begin a dialog between industry and leading scientists on seafood sustainability. Key conclusions: recognize competent authorities, speak out on science and ...
