## Ocean Trust's 2008 Kemp's Ridley Sea Turtle Restoration Program

The Tepehuajes Sea Turtle Camp is the second largest facility on the Gulf of Mexico in terms of nests and turtle eggs protected. It was constructed and is maintained by the US and Mexican shrimp industry together with Ocean Trust. In the nesting season, daily patrols relocate eggs into protected corals for the incubation period removing land-based predation, monitor nesting activities, and release turtle hatchlings into the sea. With continued support, we hope to see the Kemp's ridley sea turtle downlisted from its endangered status in the next few years. The 2007 nest count exceeded 2006 levels with over 15,000 nests and 1 million hatchlings released. There is an continuing need for additional trailers to transport eggs and hatchlings and other items to support the project. Each year we also help with logistics for media crews, funding officials, and trade journalists who visit the camp, so please stay involved as the project begins to reach a higher public profile.
